

TASO Tarrant Soccer Officials Chapter 2026-2027 Letter of Agreement

1. School Participation

In consideration of the following terms, the TASO Tarrant Soccer Officials Chapter agrees to provide soccer officiating services for the Fall 2026 through Spring 2027 soccer seasons. For Varsity games, every effort will be made to assign three officials, except for tournament games, which will be assigned two officials (Dual system). If assigning three officials is not possible, two officials (Dual system) will be assigned.

2. Preliminary Schedules

A schedule listing soccer scrimmages, tournaments, and season games—including date, time, location, level (Varsity, Junior Varsity, Junior Varsity 2), gender, and home and away teams—must be submitted to the Soccer Assignor no later than November 1st. Tournament schedules may be submitted without team names and updated once the final schedule is completed. All schedules should be emailed using the approved Excel spreadsheet to Mickey O'Brien at refmickey.obrien@gmail.com.

3. Changes to Schedules

Any changes to the submitted schedule must be communicated as soon as possible via email to Mickey O'Brien at refmickey.obrien@gmail.com.

4. Game Day Cancellations

All game day cancellations—including those due to extreme weather, field conditions, or transportation issues—must be submitted by email to Assignor Mickey O'Brien at refmickey.obrien@gmail.com. Cancellation must occur at least two hours prior to the scheduled kickoff time to allow for proper notification of game officials.

UIL 1204. Cancellations

- Weather-related cancellations:
- If the chapter or assigned officials are not notified within two hours of the scheduled game time, officials will be paid mileage.
- If an official arrives at the game site before the game is cancelled, the official will receive both the game fee and mileage.
- If multiple games are scheduled and officials are dismissed before or during the first contest, they will be paid the game fee plus mileage for the first scheduled contest.
- If multiple games are scheduled and officials are held at the site until the scheduled start of the second or subsequent games, they should be paid the game fee for all games for which they were present at the scheduled start time.

5. Scrimmage Information

The TASO Tarrant Chapter requests that all scrimmage games be paid directly to the individual official. Game fees and travel compensation for scrimmages are the same as during the regular season.

6. Game Fees

For the 2026-2027 scrimmage, non-district and district games (30, 35 or 40 min halves), fees are as follows: Referee receives \$80, each Assistant Referee receives \$60, and any game officiated by a single referee will be compensated at \$120. <https://www.uiltexas.org/athletics/officials-fee-schedule>
